You'll have to calculate your greenhouse gas emissions. You'll have to sign a declaration that you're aware that it's an offence to give false or misleading information on the form.

Sustainability declaration 

Please complete this form. A guideline will be available to assist completion - refer to the Department of Infrastructure and Planning's website www.dip.qld.gov.au

From 1 January 2010, the completion of a sustainability declaration is a mandatory requirement under the Building Act 1975 when selling a house or a house under construction. This declaration is designed to help sellers and buyers understand both how to make homes more sustainable and the potential for ongoing savings from energy efficient features. This declaration can be completed by the property owner or a representative of the owner. It must be made available to prospective buyers of the property as it is on the market, including at property inspections. If the property is advertised through a website the declaration should be available prior to the website advertisement. The website link to the sustainability declaration will need to be referenced in all other advertisements (other than in a newspaper or magazine). If the declaration is used to market the property, the form will need to be provided to the agent by the seller to enable them to advertise the dwelling at a competitive price. Under the Building Act 1975, if you require further assistance in completing this declaration, a fact sheet and detailed guideline are available at www.dip.qld.gov.au.
