<u>The Mannkal Economic Education Foundation</u> and <u>Economists for Ukraine</u> accepted submissions for the Ideas Have Consequences Contest. Some of the winners presented their projects at the <u>Free Market Road Show</u> (FMRS) event in April 2024.

About the Ideas Have Consequences Contest

The Ideas Have Consequences Contest aimed to recognize and encourage undergraduate student scholarship, developing formal research projects and policy documents to rebuild Ukraine's post-war economy. The Mannkal Economic Education Foundation and Economists for Ukraine invited essays exploring, advancing, challenging, or applying the ideas of post-war reconstruction.

Students developed the suggestions made by Ron Manners AO in <u>the Warsaw/Kyiv Free</u> <u>Market Road Show speech</u> to create/identify/design policies for rebuilding Ukraine's postwar economy. The damage to Ukraine's infrastructure and economy from Russia's war exceeds \$700 billion. Economists for Ukraine are developing frameworks and collaboration networks to support current and future reconstruction efforts. <u>You can learn more here.</u>
